You are qualified to vote if:

You are a citizen of the United States.

You are 17 years old and will be 18 years old on or by the General Election day on November 8, 2022.

You have been a resident of Ohio for at least 30 days before the election.

## METHODS FOR REGISTRATION:

You may register in person at any of the following locations: The office of the Secretary of State or any of the 88 county boards of elections. The office of any deputy registrar of the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles. Offices of designated agencies that provide public assistance or disability programs. Public Libraries.

Public Schools or Vocational Schools.

County Treasurers' offices.

## **VOTER IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

Every voter will be required to provide proof of identity before voting. The form of identification you may use includes:

Your current and valid photo identification card.

Military identification.

A copy of a current utility bill.

A bank statement.

A paycheck, government check.

A government document showing your name and current address.
